This event was very special because a 13-year-old Girl Scout led the way to make it possible. Maddie Caballero, daughter of Michael and Kathryn Caballero, and member of Girl Scout Cadette Troop 2935 in Alexandria planned and hosted the fundraiser along with her parents and siblings.

About 50 parishioners gathered to enjoy friendship, refreshments, and the background music of a cellist Daren Shumate of Alexandria. Everyone seemed to appreciate the variety of cheeses donated by Trader Joe's at Bailey's Crossroads. All were happy for Betty Joe Lash when she won the beautiful gift basket and certificate contributed by The Curious Grape in Shirlington.

After meeting with Maddie and her family, I learned that she devoted herself to the project to help build her leadership and decision-making skills and to increase the awareness of the financial needs within Catholic religious institutes across the country. All the challenges in planning

The evening was most enjoyable and it gave me an opportunity to express the gratitude of the religious for all who have contributed to SOAR! over the past 22 years and the National Religious Retirement Fund since 1988 as well. A special thank you was extended to the Michael Caballero Family, especially Maddie, for hosting such a pleasant and profitable event for SOAR! Maddie deserves The Girl Scout Silver Award.

As the participants left the fundraiser, they gave good will offerings totaling \$3,850—enough for a SOAR! grant. Typically, grants range from \$2500-\$25,000.

58 Religious Congregations Will Share \$1 Million in Grants

On February 4 the SOAR! board of directors approved of 58 grants to religious congregations in 23 states totaling \$1 million. The awards range from \$5,500 to \$25,000 to help upgrade elevators; install wander guard, call bell, and fire alarm systems; and replace roofs and windows.

Since its founding, SOAR! has distributed almost 800 grants totaling \$9 million to religious institutes in 43 states and Puerto Rico.
