Saying Thanks SOAR! helps donors share gratitude

Rather than a way to "pay it forward," John Sherwood of West Virginia likes to think of giving to SOAR! as a way to "pay it backwards" to help the religious who formed him — specifically the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur, who taught him in school.

He remembered running into them years later:

...I was sitting in a funeral parlor for my dad's viewing when two ladies, very smartly dressed, walked up to me and said, "Oh, John Michael, we are so sorry for your loss." Since I had dropped "Michael" from my name as soon as I graduated from 8th grade, I knew they had to be the nuns from at least 25 years earlier. Apparently they regularly reviewed the obituaries in the Baltimore Sun and visited their former students! I was moved, thankful and surprised, since I had never seen them other than in their black habits.

SOAR! donors have shared many moving stories about how Sisters, Brothers and Priests changed their lives.

Mike and Marianne Fenwick of Nebraska say that their donation is nothing compared to the blessings they received from these selfless men and women.

"I did not even realize the foundation for morality and justice that was started in me until my wife and I raised our own four children," Mr. Fenwick writes.

"I can never repay these fine religious men and women but please know that...they are always remembered, respected and regarded as unselfish models of how to follow Jesus."




