
SOAR! 2022 Grant Awards

Thanks to the generosity of our donors and foundations, 2022 was another banner year. The SOAR! board of directors approved more than \$1.8 million in grants to assist aging Catholic Sisters, Brothers and Priests in the United States. This surpasses last year's total of \$1,768,374.

Because of your generosity, SOAR! provided 83 grants that will benefit the care, health and safety of aging religious in 67 communities. The grants awarded included funds for practical needs as well for emergency and COVID-19 Recovery.

After two years of hosting virtual events, we think "It's Time to Celebrate!" Our fall events will be back in person this year.




