A few years ago, the Daughters of Our Lady of the Garden decided to apply for a grant from SOAR! for stairlifts. The Sisters' ministry includes running a Montessori school.

One of the Sisters was not so sure about the grant request. She doubted the usefulness and practicality of stairlifts in helping the Sisters remain mobile. This Sister was a cornerstone of the local community. She was well-known and beloved, not only by the Sisters, but also by the parents and the children at the school.

When the Sister became sick, however, her attitude completely changed! While using the stairlift may have slowed her down a bit, she was able to navigate easily between the bedroom floor and the dining room areas on the main floor to the chapel and the community room on the lower level. This allowed her to stay in tune with everything that was going on in the community and to not feel isolated. It made all the difference to her and to the Sisters who benefitted from her vitality and presence.

Sister has since passed away, but The Daughters of Our Lady of the Garden are all grateful for the life-changing gift the stairlift continues to bring to the members of their community. Thank you SOAR! donors!

Why I support SOAR!

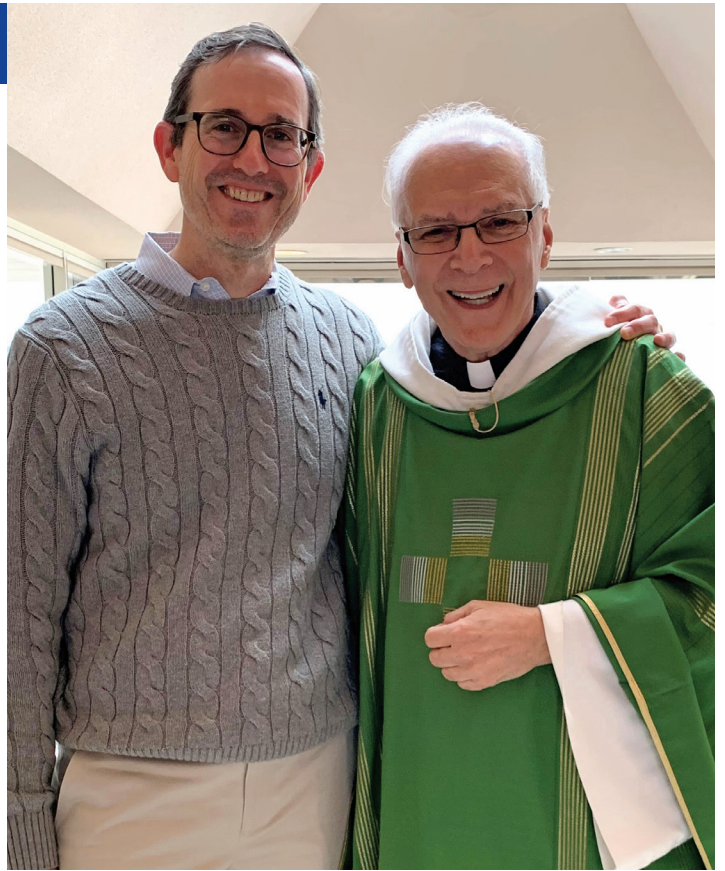
